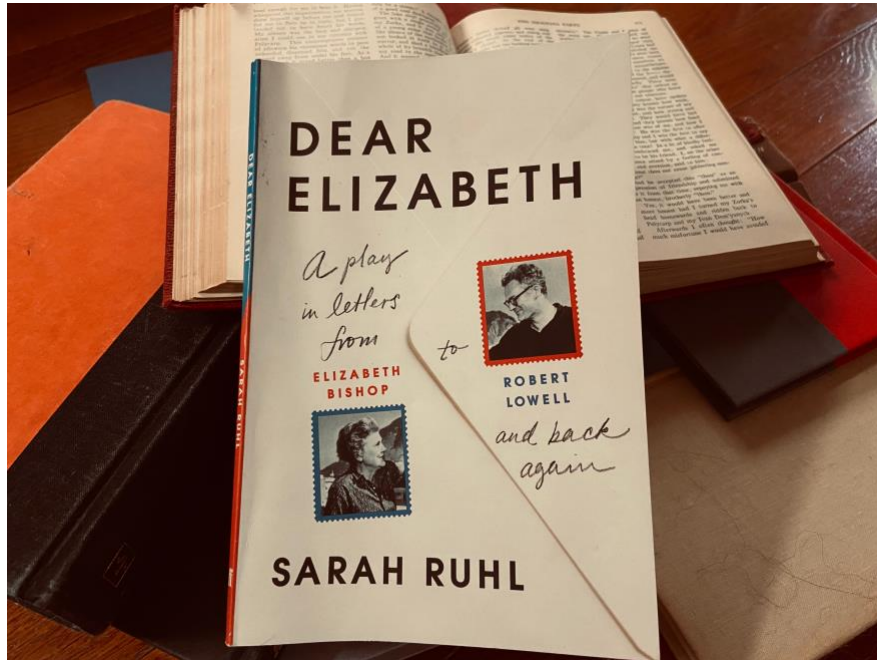

Between 1947 and 1977, poets Robert Lowell and Elizabeth Bishop exchanged more than four hundred letters. More than three decades later, playwright Sarah Ruhl fell in love with their correspondence and challenged herself to turn this thirty-year exchange into a play, bringing to life the friendship of two remarkable writers. Starring Robin Magdahlen and Patrick Tango, and directed by Wendy Wilcox, *Dear Elizabeth* is a moving and innovative portrait of a conversation of letters, illuminating some of the finest poems of the twentieth century and the minds that produced them.
